Some highlights

- In collaboration with Wilderlands, Cassinia
 Environmental and the Traditional Owners of the
 land, we help protect and conserve 14 endangered
 species at Mount Sandy in South Australia.
- Together with the Friends Of Escarpment Park, we help clear invasive species from the Toowoomba escarpment forests, Queensland.
- In Victoria we run "WildLife" day camps with Scripture Union, introducing all ages to the wonders of God's creation.
- We advise schools, colleges, venues, and campsites on how to manage their land to benefit wildlife and increase biodiversity.
- We speak to churches, schools, and colleges about the Christian basis for creation care and seek to resource them.
